

Covid-19 Guidance – Staying safe whilst enjoying sailing at Silver Wing Sailing Club

General Site Information – the Club is now in TIER 4

Please do not come to the club if you or any members of your household are suffering from any of the symptoms of Covid-19 or have been tested positive for Covid-19.

Please do not attend the club if you have been required to self-isolate by the track and trace service and that period has not expired; or (b) you are aware of any other circumstances that mean you should be self-isolating and that period has not expired; or (c) you should be adhering to quarantine or equivalent restrictions as a result of foreign travel.

Please adhere to the specific guidance which states you should stay local - meaning avoiding travelling outside of your village, town or the part of a city where you live. Please don't travel from areas in lower tiers.

Whilst at the club, it is important to regularly wash your hands or use the hand sanitisers that are readily available around site.

At all times, maintain Social Distancing (2 metres or at least 1 metre plus with mitigation) & always be vigilant and considerate of others.

Please ensure you comply with the current rules which state that you can only visit with the people you live with or, when on your own, with 1 person from another household. No mingling either, please!

For track & trace compliance we request you register on arrival using the NHS app, the SWSC QR code or by recording your name & contact details using the book found by the main entrance to the clubhouse. Any details recorded will be retained for the required 21 days.

The club reminds all sailors of the need, under the current conditions, to sail within the limits of their skill and equipment and not to place reliance on patrol boats or third-party support.

Clubhouse & Changing Room Information

The main clubhouse is currently closed. The changing rooms & toilets are open and available for use. Facemasks should be worn when using them. The maximum capacity is limited to two in the men's changing room & one in the ladies changing room

There is signage at the changing rooms doors indicating when they are occupied. Please ensure social distancing when using them and do not leave any items of kit in the changing rooms. If possible, we recommend arriving changed or discretely changing in the carpark.

The showers should only be used in emergencies.

Please use the antibacterial spray provided, for cleaning any surfaces you touch before and after using the changing rooms & toilet area.

Lockers for valuables are available in the sailing shed by the race briefing blackboard. It is recommended that keys are cleaned with antibacterial spray or sanitiser.
